READ

Micah 3:5-12

ASK

- What are prophets and what did they do?

Parents: How did Micah stand up for what was right? Can you share a story of a time when you stood up for what was right?

- Why is it important to remember that we have “eyewitnesses” in our lives? (Re-read 1 Thessalonians 2:10)

- If it were your job to bring news from God like Micah did to your friends, how would you feel delivering it?

Parents: Can you share of a time when you delivered Good News to your friends? What were you feeling? How was the story received?

- How will you choose to do what’s right this week?

PRAY

Pray and thank God for the example we can find in Micah.

Help us to choose what is right and be brave In the things that he wants us to do.

READ

Amos 5:18-24

ASK

- What do you remember about Amos? (Was he a major or minor prophet?)
Do you know what the different between the Major and Minor Prophets are?
- What was the breaking news Amos had for the people of Israel?
- What does Matthew 25:13 have to do with Amos and the story in Amos 5?
- How will you choose to show genuine worship to God this week?
- How will you be sincere when you worship this week?

Parents: Can you come up with a list of Ideas with your kids on how you can be sincere and show genuine worship to God this week?

PRAY

Pray and thank God for the words
he gave the prophet Amos.

Teach us how to let the things we do
match the things we say, and help us
to remember that we can worship you in
small and big ways.

ASK

Need a refresher: 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11

- Has there ever been a time when you felt like you weren't sure you could trust God?

Parents: Do you have a story you can share about a time where you felt couldn't trust God? How did things turn out?

- How can we trust God in our everyday lives?

Come up with some ideas as a family on how you can trust God this week.

PRAY

Pray that we can remember the message of Zephaniah in our life.

Help us to trust you no matter what is happening around us.

Parents: Has there even been a time when you heard from God? What was your experience?
